- I. The Details of Enoch's life are few, but they show...
- 1. He lived at a very wicked time
- 2. He faced the anxieties of raising a family
- 3. He was missed—"Not found."

Hebrews 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

- II. What is meant by "Enoch walked with God"?
