How People Quench The SPIRIT and Why They Should NOT!

• I Thess. 5:19- Quench Not the SPIRIT.

•The Greek word for "put out" or "quench" means to extinguish, to stifle, and to retard. The Holy Spirit throughout Scripture is depicted as a fire. The Apostle is saying, "Don't pour water on that fire."

Ephesians 4:30 "Grieve not the Holy Spirit."

I. The SPIRIT may be grieved by refusing to obey impulses in us when He wants us to SPEAK or ACT for Him.

2. The SPIRIT may be grieved by the method of public worship in a congregation.

3. The Spirit may be grieved from a spirit of pride, fashion and world display.

- 4. The Spirit may be grieved because of Criticism and Controversy.
- These are FATAL to the working of the Holy Ghost.

2. HE GLORIFIES CHRIST TO US

2 Corinthians 3:18 "And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

3. HE WANTS TO GUIDE YOU INTO GOD'S WILL

Jeremiah 10:23

"I know, O Lord, that a man's way is not in himself, nor is it in a man who walks to direct his steps."

4. HE STRENGTHENS US

Ephesians 3:16 "I pray that you might be strengthened in the inner man by the Spirit," The only way you're going to do God's will, and glorify Christ is when your power is coming from the Holy Spirit.
