Ways To Make Your Faith Grow

1. Feed your faith... through the word.

Psalm 34:8 ⁸ Oh, taste and see that the Lord *is* good; Blessed *is* the man *who* trusts in Him!

John 14:26 ²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

1. Feed your faith... through the word.

- Reading the Word allows the Holy Spirit to bring to our remembrance exactly what we need to apply to our daily situations.



2. Speak to your faith... to make it grow.

2 *Corinthians* 4:13 ¹³ And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak

- There are also times when you will speak about things of faith before they even manifest in the natural realm.

2. Speak to your faith... to make it grow.

Romans 4:17 **17** (as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

**3. Free your faith from negativity.
“Feed your faith and starve your doubts”**

James 1:6 ⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.


4. Believe the impossible as possible.

Luke 1:37 ³⁷ For with God nothing is ever impossible and no word from God shall be without power or impossible without fulfillment.

Hebrews 11:6 ⁶ But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

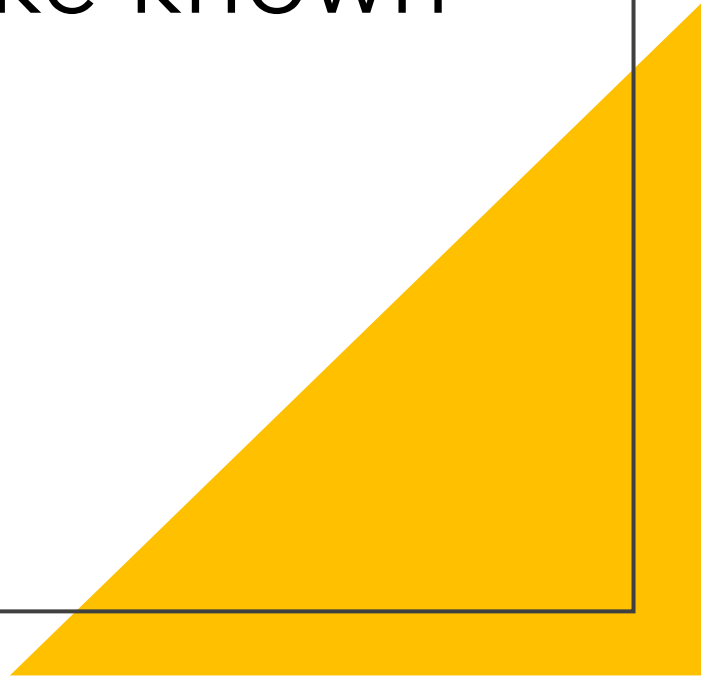
4. Believe the impossible as possible.

According to Strong's Concordance the Greek word for *rewarder* is *misthapodotes* (G3406) and it means:
"One who pays wages, a rewarder"
